



Download Instructions for Parents


Download the Gamebuilder Software (Intro, Sequel, Racecar, or Advance d):

1. Go to the game creators' website <http://www.yoyogames.com/gamemaker/windows>
2. Chose GameMaker 8.1 Lite
3. Chose Run

Download the Scratch Animation Software:

1. Go to the software creators' website: http://info.scratch.mit.edu/Scratch_1.4_Download
2. Select Scratch Installer for Windows and click on Scratch Installer 1.4.exe
3. Chose Run

Download the Resources Folder:

1. Go to the Active Learning Downloads website to download the the software <http://activelearningdownloads.com/>
2. Click on "Resources"
3. Chose either Gamemaker (for Intro, Sequel, or Racecar) or Scratch (for Animation).
4. When you click on the word "here" a zip file will begin to download containing the resources for the games or projects. These include images of ships, spacecraft, animals, sounds etc. that are used to create the games.
5. Click on Application Menu at the top  and choose "Save As"
6. Save it in a folder for camper to access images

Download Your Child's Project:

1. Log on to <http://activelearningcamps.com>
2. Scroll down, Click: Camp Downloads (left hand side)
3. Find: Camp Date and Session (note: in some camps all games or scratch projects will be included under the AM session)
4. Right Click on campers' game and choose "Save Link As..." or "Save Target As..."
5. Make sure *Save As Type* is "All Files" **not html**
6. **Add ".gmk"** to file name for Gamemaker files and ".sb" to Scratch Animation Files
7. Click Save
8. Open Game Maker Software (Gamebuilder Games) or Scratch Software (Scratch Projects)
9. File, Open, find the file you saved, and open.
10. Click the green play button (top bar) and enjoy your game.
